3D PAPER PUMPKIN SCULPTURE


Makes a 8"x 8" Pumpkin


Materials:

- Scissors
- Tacky glue or white glue
- 8.5" x 11" Cardstock paper (White or colored)

Instructions:

- 1. Print pumpkin template (6 pumpkin sheets + 1 instructions sheet).
- 2. Cut out island pieces with scissors.
- Score along dot-dash and dashed lines using a ruler and a thick sewing needle, a paper clip, or an embossing tool.
- 4. Fold dot-dash and dashed lines following the guide shown in **Figure 1**.
- 5. Connect tabs to corresponding islands
 (Figure 2.) and glue on blank side of tab.
 Pumpkin builds from top to bottom.
 Start on Island labeled number 1. Have fun!





Key: Island # : Edge #

How to read tabs example: Tab reads "10:2". Locate Island 10 and glue tab to Edge 2. Apply glue to blank side of tab (non-printed side). Adhere directly on edge number of printed side.

Blank tabs: Work on numbered tabs first and blank tabs will be evident as to which edge and island they connect to.
