

Getting Started with Worbla

Worbla is used in many ways, but here's a quick guide to getting started with Deco Art.

Remember Worbla is hot when activated! Use caution when applying heat.

Gloves are not mandatory for Deco Art, but we do suggest using them, especially for initial shaping.



Made with Worbla



Work on a non-stick work surface!
(Parchment paper or silicone sheet)



Use work gloves with latex or nitrile gloves over them



Pour Deco Art into a silicone container or bowl lined with parchment paper



Heat evenly with a heat gun
(you can also use hot water)



Deco Art turns translucent when ready



Knead pellets together
(keep gloves wet to prevent sticking)



Shape by hand or press into a rubber or silicone mold



Deco Art stays fluid until cool
(place pieces in cold water to 'set')



Deco Art will bond to many surfaces such as plastic, wood, and paper
(always test before beginning a project)



Reheat pieces to fix mistakes or to join together



Prime and paint!
