# Count Bugs Placemat

## ➔ Math Matters - Learn Numbers and Counting

### Step 1: Parents with 1 – 3 year olds

- ❖ Teach number recognition: Say the number and point to each letter
- ❖ Say the number and hold up the number of fingers on your hand equal to the number you are saying
- ❖ Ask the child to repeat the number and point to it on the placemat when saying the number

### Step 2: Parents with 2 – 4 year olds

- ❖ Count the bugs: Teach counting by counting the number of bugs next to the number on the front of the placemat
- ❖ Put 12 blueberries in a bowl. Take one blueberry out and put it next to #1 and say, "One blueberry". Repeat with two, three and so on with your child
- ❖ Highlight the name of the insects on the placemat

### Step 3: Child aged 3 – 6

- ❖ Trace numbers on the back side following the arrows
- ❖ Count the bugs on your own and write the answer
- ❖ Learn number names in English, French, Spanish & Chinese
